Dr. Mike Lowry, DDS

Dr. Lowry has been in practice for over 36 years and has been involved in orthodontics since taking his first course with Dr. Rondeau in 1987. Over the time since then, Dr. Lowry has studied with Rondeau Seminars, United States Dental Institute, various instructors teaching TMD and facial pain, facial beauty institute, and the IAO instructors institute. He currently holds the designation of Master Senior Instructor with the IAO. Dr. Lowry has served as president of the IAO and was on the executive committee for 5 years. He is currently retired from private practice but his practice consisted of roughly 30 % orthodontics and he treated all phases of orthodontics including orthopedics, TMD, and sleep. Dr. Lowry has achieved the level of Diplomat and has served as chair of the International Board of Orthodontics and is still a member. As such, he is involved in the IAO Professional Advancement program and is serving as an examiner for students involved in undertaking that process. He is also a reviewer for the peer review program for IAO journal articles awaiting submission. Until recently, Dr. Lowry assisted Dr. Rondeau with the level 1 courses in Vancouver, Calgary and Edmonton and other locations as needed. He is the mentor for two study clubs in Alberta, one in Vancouver and one in Saskatchewan.

Learning Outcomes:


- Attendees will learn to use a lightwire one block appliance to address

Dr. Timothy Adams is a renowned leader in the dental community, with over 35 years of experience in the field of dentistry. Dr. Adams is known for his expertise in cosmetic dentistry, neuromuscular dentistry, occlusion, TMJ, sleep, and his focus on fusing form, function, and aesthetics. He believes that beauty must align with function, and changes in the bite can rejuvenate or have the opposite effect if an inexperienced doctor doesn't understand the importance of this relationship. Dr. Adams is passionate about improving health and wellness through improved craniofacial function, jaw joint function, sutural homeostasis, and breathing. He believes the body is interconnected, and changes in one part of the body can impact other parts. Cranial strains and patterns of the cranial bones in our head affect jaw positions that directly affect our head and neck posture, TMJ, cervical stability, spinal column, tongue position, breathing and the autonomic nervous system.
